

## **Bordentown City Recycling Information**

### **Curbside Pickup:**

Burlington County Regional Recycling Program offers curbside pickup of household recyclables every second Monday. Accepted materials include paper (including cardboard), aluminum and steel/tin food and beverage cans, glass bottles and jars, and plastic bottles (only those with a neck and #1 or #2 on the bottom). Blue recycling buckets are available at no cost at City Hall (324 Farnsworth Avenue) and Public Works Department (209 Crosswicks Street).

### **Local Drop-Off:**

Bordentown City Public Works Department (298-0654) accepts drop-off of recyclable materials at its Recycling Center at the Gilder Field Complex (209 Crosswicks Street). The hours are Saturday, 8am - noon. Accepted materials include used motor oil, household paint (oil-based and latex), cans, bottles, paper/cardboard, grass, leaves, branches and stumps, appliances and scrap metal. No commercial contractors are permitted. Proof of City residency is required.
